1. Ice Breaker

• What's a funny or creative excuse you've used (or heard) for avoiding responsibility?

2. Discussion Questions

- Excuses get in the way of leaving a legacy of significance. What kind of legacy do you want to leave? How can you start living a life of significance today?
- Out of the excuses that Moses makes, which one do you often make?
 - Identity (Exodus 3:11)
 - Insecurity (Exodus 3:13)
 - Influence (Exodus 4:1)
 - Inadequacy (Exodus 4:10)
 - Irrationality (Exodus 4:13)
- What's one broken area in the world that bothers you the most?
- Read Exodus 4:2-9 What is it that God has placed in your hand that God can use to influence the broken area that bothers you the most?
- God wants to use your identity, income and influence for His purposes. What's your next step to be the solution God wants to bring to a problem in this world?
