How to Save Your Marriage from Your Kids

Leaders: We understand that not everyone in your group may be married nor have kids. As always, feel free to adapt the questions to best fit your group. You can reword them to talk about someone group members know and can disciple just as Timothy was Paul's spiritual son (1 Timothy 1:2).

LEAN IN

- Tell about a time when your kids or you as a kid tried to be the "CEO" of the home.

LOOK DOWN *Read Deuteronomy 6:4-9*

- What are some specific moments in your daily routine when you can point kids to Christ?
- Loving God with everything isn't just a feeling or some words, it's also an action. Why is love in action important to your marriage and parenting?

LOOK OUT

- Kids spend 1% of their week at church, how does this change your perspective of the role of parents as the largest spiritual influence in the life of their kids?
- What does successful parenting look like? How do you know a parent is accomplishing what God intended for them to?

LOOK IN

- Can you think of a time when you felt exhausted (physically or emotionally) because of your family, but it was totally worth it? Why was it worth it?
- How can you focus on seeing spiritual fruit instead of comparing yourself to others?
- What's your next step to partner with God in seeing more spiritual fruit in your family?
