Leader Guide

Lean In (#1) - As your group time begins, use this section to stimulate discussion and energy and get everyone in the group involved.

Unfortunately, answers may vary of really good, to not-so-good with this question. Some of us may be more known for being judgmental than being loving. Or, some of us may be known for our hospitality. Have fun with this question!

Look Down (#2) - Read John 3:16-17. Read it once outloud then take 5-10 minutes and silently reflect on the passage. God desires to be known and identified by one thing -- His love. How should that change what we are known for?

Look Down (#3 & #4) - Read Acts 15:12-21 (you can read the whole chapter as a group if you would like greater context. In this passage, there is a tension between Gentiles (non-Jewish believers) and Jewish believers. There is so muc tension that it begins to de-rail the mission of the church and the Christians who are present. Consider the tension-filled world we live in. How can we help even the people we don't like and disagree with know we are FOR them?
