LEAN IN

- How do you see Mary balancing faith and obedience in this verse? What does this teach us about the relationships between trust and action?

LOOK OUT

- How can we, like Mary, live obediently to God in a world that often values control and independence?
- Who in your life might need encouragement to trust God with something big or unknown? How can you support them in saying "yes" to God?

LOOK IN

- Think about a dream or calling that seems impossible. How might God be inviting you to trust Him, even if you don't know the outcome?
- What is one practical step you can take this week to surrender your plans to God and trust Him, even if you don't know the outcome?
